Alan works within the urban regeneration sector with specific responsibility for residential lead projects. He is also director of sustainability at Sheppard Robson and leads the research and development of its sustainability programme, conducting industry seminars, and ensuring that policies are integrated into all design processes. He received his degree & diploma in architecture from Leicester Polytechnic and studied design for extreme environments at the University of Houston, SICSA .
