What is PechaKucha?

With its roots in Tokyo PechaKucha, a Japanese term for the sound of conversation, is a unique event for creative people to meet, network, and show their work in public. Every presenter gets 20 images that each will be shown for 20 seconds, which means that every speaker has exactly 6 minutes and 40 seconds to deliver their message.

PechaKucha is a format that makes presentations concise and keeps things moving at a rapid pace. This phenomenon has spread troughout the world and more than 400 cities now have their own Pecha-Kucha Night event.
